GRR 7501 Statistical Methods Applied to Research

Fundamentals of statistics as applied to master's degree research, including population, sample, parameter, statistics, and variable; the branches of statistics, sources of data, sampling concepts, sample selection methods; analysis and interpretation of data using statistics software (3 units)

GRR 7502 Research Methods across Disciplines

Methods and designs, concepts, processes, tools and interpretation of results of research in different disciplines (3 units; Prerequisite: GRR 7501)

GPY 7103 Advanced Developmental Psychology

Traditional and contemporary theories of human development, their application in describing social and cultural conditions that organize an individual's life experience within a chosen age-range of the lifespan. (3 units)

GPY 7201 Advanced Theories of Personality

Personality theories and old and contemporary issues in the study of personality; biographies, assessment methods and therapies and anecdotes included (3 units)

GPY 7202 Advanced Abnormal Psychology

Psychological illnesses and application of bio-psychosocial model in the analysis of mental illness, including interactions with actual patients, their families, and health caregivers in hospital and community settings (3 units)

GPY 7203 Advanced Psychological Assessment

Historical, theoretical, statistical, and practical bases of measurement of psychological attributes and constructs; procedures and standards for construct explication, test construction and item analysis, establishment of reliability and validity of measures, establishment of norms, construction of test manual, and administration, scoring, and interpretation of test scores; psychological tests in educational, industrial and government settings (3 units)

GPY 7204 Advanced Clinical Psychology

Abnormal behavior and mental processes; scientific principles in assessment, classification and treatment of psychological disorders (3 units)

GPY 7205 Group Process

Theoretical and experiential understanding of the group, purpose, development, dynamics and group counseling methods and skills and other group approaches (3 units)

GPY 7900 Practicum

Off-campus internship of students in three settings—clinical, industrial and school (3 units)

GPY 7907 Research Colloquium (1 unit)

GRR 7700 Comprehensive Examination

Prerequisite: Completion of all course work (0 units)

GRR 7980 Thesis 1

Selection and presentation of research topic, writing and oral defense of research proposal (3 units; Prerequisite: GRR 7700 Comprehensive Examinations)

GRR 7990 Thesis 2

Conducting, writing, and oral defense of master's thesis approved in Thesis 1 (3 units; Prerequisite: GRR 7980 - Thesis 1)
