CORE

GED 7101 Psychological Foundations of Education

Deals with the application of psychology to education, the determinants of behavior, how students learn, the transfer and management of learning, emotional, physical, and social factors in learning, and teacher-student relationships. (3 units)

GRR 7501 Statistical Methods Applied to Research

Fundamentals of statistics as applied to master's degree research, including population, sample, parameter, statistics, and variable; the branches of statistics, sources of data, sampling concepts, sample selection methods; analysis and interpretation of data using statistics software (3 units)

GRR 7502 Research Methods across Disciplines

Methods and designs, concepts, processes, tools and interpretation of results of research in different disciplines (3 units)

GED 7200 Multimedia in Education

Is critical in the implementation of blended learning; It involves use of online learning and teaching tools to deliver teaching content with available and relevant educational technologies (3 units)

MAJOR

GPH 7101 Philosophy of History

A critical examination of the nature of historical knowledge and objectivity in history, the problems of universal history including philosophical issues and controversies set forth in the writings of historical philosophers starting from the pre-literary historical period to the present. (3 units)

GIH 7103 International History – The World Since 1914

A study of important developments in major areas of the world from the First World War to the present (3 units)

GEH 7104 Trends in Teaching History

This course equips students with recent approaches in teaching history. Topics include detailed analyses of the theories of instruction, curricular objectives and content, teaching techniques and assessment methods. Students are required to use appropriate methods in teaching selected topics or areas in the history curriculum. (3 units)

GTH 7200 Contemporary Philippines and Southeast Asia

A study of the making of contemporary Philippines starting from the late 19th century to the present and its relations to Southeast Asian neighbors (3 units)

GCH 7102 Cultural History of Afro-Asian Nations

In-depth analysis of the cultural development of the various Afro-Asian nations critically focusing attention on the divergences and similarities in the calcification of cultures that have made African nations basically similar to one another (3 units)

GTH 7106 War in the Modern World

A critical survey of the contemporary wars from the First World War, stressing the causes – immediate and remote; attention is also focused on the effects of said wars on the various segments of the world society. (3 units)

GTH 7201 20th Century India, China and Japan

An intensive study of the contemporary developments in India, China and Japan with emphasis on the new patterns each had in the various aspects of life – political, economic and social – in the 20th century. (3 units)

ELECTIVE

GTH 5005 Formation of New Societies in America

Comparative analysis of the founding and development of societies in America by Europeans from the 16th through the 18th centuries with special attention to the value systems and institutions of non-English societies (3 units)

GAH 5007 American Thought: 19th & 20th Centuries

An attempt to interpret classical works of American philosophers from the 19th century to the present (3 units)

GRH 5008 Russia from the 19th Century

An intensive study from the time of Catherine, the age of enlightenment to the present (3 units)

GTH 5102 Seminar in Philippine Culture

A study of pre-Spanish Philippines tracing the peopling of the country and the eventual development of culture in its various aspects as the foundation of what later came to be the stamp of Filipino identity (3 units)

GTH 7107 Later British History

British history in the 19th, 20th, and 21st century; a study of ideas in relation to social and political movements (3 units)

GRR 7700 Comprehensive Examination

Prerequisite: Completion of all course work. (0 units)

GRR 7903 Action Research

Research designed to diagnose education problems or weaknesses to help educators solve them practically, quickly and efficiently (3 units, Prerequisite: Completion of all course work)

GRR 7904 Case Writing in Education

Writing reports on analysis of cases in education (3 units, Prerequisite: GRR 793)

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
